Code of Conduct
Rules and Regulations

Acceptance into the Bud Carlson Academy requires a commitment to trying new ways of performing and meeting educational goals. Candidates who see themselves as motivated and able to benefit from the opportunity are encouraged to apply. By signing this application you agree to follow the expectations set forth by the Academy and commit to taking responsibility for working toward your educational goals in partnership with the Academy.

1. The Bud Carlson Academy is a drug free school zone and any student under the influence, possessing and/or selling drugs or alcohol will be suspended for 10 days and referred to the School Board Discipline Committee for possible expulsion.
2. Students will be respectful of the rights of others. Insubordination, disrespect and defamation will not be tolerated, nor will swearing at staff or other students. Vulgarity, defiance, insolence, disrespect and fighting are unacceptable behaviors. Public displays of affection are not condoned.
3. Students may not smoke, store, or have in their possession any tobacco products or lighters in school buildings, on school property, or at any school function. Smoking is a violation of statutory law and may also result in court action. There is NO SMOKING ON COMMUNITY CENTER PROPERTY.
4. If a student is absent from the BCA it is his or her responsibility to call the school to notify staff of the reason. THE PHONE NUMBER IS 332-3678 EXT. 138
5. If a student drives to school he or she is to park in the assigned student parking lot. Once the car is parked on school property it is to remain there until the school day is over. Students are not allowed to drive to lunch and at no time during the day are they permitted to give rides to other students.
6. Students are not allowed to use the phone in the main office for personal calls. The pay phone by the snack machine can be used only during breaks. Please limit calls to three minutes or less.
7. Pagers and cell phones are to be turned off during school hours. Music must be played at a low volume with school appropriate lyrics. Continued use of CD players and headphones is up to the discretion of the classroom teacher.
8. During breaks students are to behave appropriately or the group will lose break privileges. During breaks you must remain in the building. Appropriate language is expected at all times.
9. Friends are not allowed in or around the building during school hours 7:30-7:30.
10. Students are NOT ALLOWED on Spaulding High School property during school hours. Any violation of this rule will result in trespassing charges.
11. Students are only allowed on the Community Center property when they are scheduled for classes at the Academy.

12. Students taking D-Block Career and Technical Education classes must sign in at the Tech Center Office.

*Remember: The honor of the group is equal to that of the individual. The BCA reputation requires you to conduct yourself as mature, responsible young adults. Consequences for breaking any of the above listed codes could result in any of the following: Dismissal from the BCA, After School Detention, Suspension, Probation, Contract, Group Review/Trial.
