**Application Process**

The R.W. Creteau Regional Technology Center is offering the opportunity to selected students for nomination into the National Technical Honor Society. The NTHS Committee will present the awards based on the following combination of factors: grade point average, number of absences, letter of application, post-graduate goals, instructor recommendations, and other relevant accomplishments.

Students must meet these requirements:

1. Desire to pursue a career goal
2. Scholastic achievement of 90 (B+) or better in a Career Technical program
3. Meet 100% of the program level competencies to date at the advanced or proficient level as required by the state for program completers
4. Have a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale
5. **Less than 10** absences per year (excluding field trips, school activities, extended health issues)
6. A student in good standing at home school and R.W. Creteau Regional Technology Center
7. Demonstrate leadership, character and citizenship activities (i.e. school extracurricular activities, career technical student organization activities, annual community service activities, church activities, etc.)

After meeting the above criteria, the student will qualify with these two components.

- 1. Completed NTHS membership application form**
- 2. Review of school records-** a transcript of grades, attendance and behavior will be reviewed by the NTHS Selection Committee.

The NTHS Selection Committee will accept applications for nomination to the society until Monday, April 6, 2009.
